ELIGIBILITY

1. High School senior student, who will be graduating in the **Spring of 2017**
2. Parents must be registered parishioners of St. Philip the Apostle Parish, Huffman, Texas, or a member of St. Philip Council #9794 Knights of Columbus.

QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS:

1. College or Trade School of choice.
2. Major Field of study.
3. Essay as to importance of scholarship. (ie Hardship, needs, interest)
4. Activities in school.
5. Transcript of High School grades.
6. Must be a full time student carrying a minimum of 12 hours per semester.
7. Must maintain a minimum 2.0 average or better, in all course work.
8. Need for financial assistance is important.

Student may attend any college or trade school of their choice.

A letter of recommendation from applicant's school principal and another letter from an adult (preferably, teacher, counselor, employer, etc.) must be included with the application.

In conjunction with the St. Philip's Parish, the Knights of Columbus shall award two (2) scholarships valued at \$500.00 each. The scholarships shall be \$500.00, dispersed as \$250.00 per semester. All funds shall be deposited to the Financial Aid Department of the College, Trade School or Institution in the name of the scholarship recipient and can apply towards tuition, books, lab fees, living expenses (dorm), or meals.

Grade transcript must be provided to the St. Philip Knights of Columbus Scholarship Committee after each semester.
